GOVERNOR APPOINTS MONIQUE S. LANGHORNE TO SUPERIOR COURT JUDGE

NAPA, CA—Governor Edmund G. Brown, Jr. announced today the appointment of Monique S. Langhorne to a judgeship in the Napa Superior Court. She fills the vacancy created by Judge Rodney Stone.

The Governor's Office released the following statement:

Monique S. Langhorne, 43, of Vallejo, has been appointed to a judgeship in the Napa County Superior Court. Langhorne has served as a commissioner at the Napa County Superior Court since 2006. She served as a deputy district attorney at the Napa County District Attorney's Office from 2000 to 2006 and was a family support officer at the Napa County Department of Child Support Services from 1999 to 2000. Langhorne earned a Juris Doctor degree from the University of California, Berkeley School of Law and a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of California, Berkeley. Effective December 4, 2018, she will fill the vacancy created by the retirement of Judge Rodney G. Stone. Langhorne is a Democrat.

"I'm extremely pleased to welcome Monique Langhorne as a superior court judge to our bench. Ms. Langhorne has served the court with distinction as a commissioner for the past 12 years and exemplifies the attributes that one expects of a judge. We're thankful that the Governor appointed Ms. Langhorne, which will greatly assist the Court's goal in providing access to justice", said Presiding Judge Elia Ortiz.

Commissioner Langhorne added, "It has been an honor to serve the court since 2006 and the people of Napa County since 1995. I look forward to contributing further in my new capacity as a superior court judge."
