ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE: SANCTIONS FOR FAILURE TO APPEAR

APPEARANCE REQUIRED by counsel Marie Maiolo Muchow. The Court received the Receipt and Acknowledgement of Order for the Deposit of Money Into Blocked Account (Judicial Council form MC-356). Petitioner was ordered to place \$2,382 into a blocked account. However, the initial deposit listed in MC-356 is \$800 while the present balance is reported as \$4,072.16. The Court needs evidence showing that at least \$2,832 was deposited into the account from the settlement. In light of the fact that the account balance is higher than that amount, a declaration asserting that at least \$2,832 of the balance was *from the settlement* will suffice.
