AMENDED PETITION FOR CHANGE OF NAME

TENTATIVE RULING: The father was served via mail on November 2, 2018, and then personally served in Mexico on November 9, 2018. Although not 30 days' notice under Code of Civil Procedure section 1277, the Court determines the father received sufficient notice under the circumstances. Because notice has been properly published and no written objections have been filed, the petition is GRANTED without need for appearance.

PETITION FOR CHANGE OF NAME

TENTATIVE RULING: Petitioner submitted evidence that the father is deceased and the mother's whereabouts are unknown. Under Code of Civil Procedure section 1277, subdivision (e), because the minor's parents are deceased or cannot be located, petitioner must provide 30 days' notice to the minor's grandparents, if living. Petitioner shall provide such notice or submit death certificates. In addition, petitioner shall file Declaration of Guardian (Judicial Council form NC-110G) and Decree Changing Name of Minor (By Guardian) (Judicial Council form NC-130G). The matter is continued to February 1, 2019, at 8:30 a.m. in Dept. A to allow petitioner to provide notice and file the necessary forms.
